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# **THE PROJECT**

The European project "Apprenticeships for NEETs" (ANEETS) aims to promote innovative forms of apprenticeship for vulnerable youth "Not in Education, Employment or Training" (NEET) developed by companies, professional integration actors and vocational training actors.

The project partners first carried out a European benchmarking on guidance and professionalisation measures of apprenticeship. As results of a close collaboration between companies and training centres, the ANEETS project publications highlight the necessary cooperation between the different integration and vocational training actors to enable NEETs to enter the labour market.
